## INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS COMPANIES ACT

(Cap 100A)

## International Business Companies (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 110(1) of the International Business Companies Act, the Vice-President acting as the Minister of Economic Planning and Employment hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the International Business Companies (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2005.

Citation

2. The Schedule to the International Business Companies Act is amended as follows—

Amendment of Schedule Cap. 100A

- (a) in Part 1 of the Schedule, in paragraph 1:
  - (i) by repealing subparagraphs (a), (b), (c), (g) and
    (h) and substituting therefor the following subparagraphs:
    - "(a) \$100 upon the registration by the Registrar of a company incorporated under this Act the authorised capital of which is \$100,000 or less;
    - (b) \$1000 upon the registration by the Registrar of a company incorporated under this Act the authorised capital of which exceeds \$100,000;

- (c) Repealed;
- (g) \$100 upon submission to the Registrar of articles of continuation for a company the authorised capital of which is \$100,000 or less;
- (h) \$1000 upon submission to the Registrar of articles of continuation for a company the authorised capital of which exceeds \$100,000;";
- (ii) by repealing subparagraph (r);
- (b) in Part II of the Schedule, in paragraph 2 by repealing subparagraphs (a) to (d) and substituting therefor the following subparagraphs:
  - "(a) \$100 if its authorised capital is \$100,000 or less;
    - (b) \$1000 if its authorised capital exceeds \$100,000."
